NEW CAPE CORAL NEUROSURGERY TREATMENT CENTER OPEN

CAPE CORAL, FL--October 15--Southwest Florida Neurosurgical and Rehab & Pain Management Associates are proud to announce the opening of their new Cape Coral center for the comprehensive treatment of arm, leg and back pain caused by spinal problems.

The new facility is located north of Cape Coral Hospital at 632 Del Prado Blvd., N, just 1/2 mile south of Pine Island Road. The office's phone number remains (239) 772-5577. The group's Fort Myers medical offices remain at 12700 Creekside Lane, (239) 432-0774.

Located about 1/2 mile north of the practice's former site, the new multi-million dollar building features over 27,000 square feet of space. The group's neurosurgeons will be housed on the first floor, with pain management and therapy services occupying the second floor.

Approximately 2500-square-feet of medical office space and 5500-square-feet of high end class A office space remain for lease on the third floor.

According to Neurosurgeon Wesley Faunce, M.D., the complex was constructed in an effort to meet the growing demand in Cape Coral for high-quality medical care.

"Despite the recent housing slowdown, the city's population continues to grow by leaps and bounds and our former offices just weren't able to accommodate the growth in patients," he explained. "Our commitment is to the well-being of the Cape's residents, so a larger building was a priority now and for the future."

One neurosurgeon originally served Cape Coral when the office opened in 1990. The office since has grown to three neurosurgeons, three physical medicine physicians (physiatrists) and a staff of rehabilitation specialists.

In the making for the last 18 months, the three-story building, designed by Sheely Architects, Inc., makes for a landmark site with its distinctive copper-metal roof. "The unique roof was selected to reflect the high-quality of our group's medical practice," said Neurosurgeon Don Moyer, M.D.

In fact, the building has been constructed so sturdily it can double as a hurricane shelter for up to 200 people. "This strong construction was meant to make sure all equipment and patient offerings will remain safe in spite of any weather that may strike," explained the practice's Chief Operating Officer Bob O'Grady.

Presently, the multi-specialty medical practice focuses on the advanced treatment of arm, leg and back pain caused by spinal problems. They are the only medical practice in Southwest Florida that offers the full range of both non-surgical and surgical treatment options within their office locations in Fort Myers and Cape Coral to patients seeking pain relief.
